KINGSVILLE, TX – In an effort to better serve the community, City of Kingsville City Manager Mark McLaughlin has decided to partially re-open the L.E. Ramey Golf Course while staff and contractors work to follow an improvement schedule designed to fix damage to the course and improve the golfing experience.

Beginning Friday, September 4th, the front nine holes will be open for play, the back nine will remain closed. Hole closures may fluctuate as work progresses. The Driving Range and Pro Shop will remain open.
