9. No electronics (including cell phones, cameras, mp3 players, iPods, etc.) will be allowed. Electronics will be confiscated. In case of an emergency, staff members will have cell phones for participants to use.

3. Parent/guardian will be notified immediately to pick up participant.

No running, pushing, swearing or horseplay.

All swimmers must have proper swimsuits. Women must have a lined swimsuit.

Men must have lined swim trunks.

All infants must have a Disposable Swim Diaper.

No Floaties in the pool. Only approved lifejackets are allowed.

Children 9 & under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Children 6 & under must have an adult in the water within arm's reach at all times.

All children under 18 must have a parent sign a new emergency release form to enter the pool.

Pool Parties are not allowed during regular hours.

Inappropriate contact or inappropriate use of cell phones or cameras will result in dismissal from pool

**\*Strict rules flotation devices are in place at the pool for the safety of small children.**

The pool rents for **\$40.00 per hour** with a 4 hour max plus **\$15.00 per hour** for each lifeguard required. This will be determined by a headcount of how many people are anticipated attend the party. Reservations are to be made at the Kingsville Parks Office. The rental time includes clean-up time. Any changes or cancellations must be made at least two weeks in advance to qualify for deposit refund.

### Heat Index Monitoring Guidelines

City of Kingsville Parks and Recreation Department uses the following heat index chart for monitoring all of our outdoor activities and events, with the heat index being determined hourly. The City of Kingsville Parks and Recreation Department implements the following guidelines when dealing with outdoor activities during extreme heat. This guideline is designed to provide participants with a standard for safe play during times of extreme heat. The two areas that will be taken into account when modifying or canceling activities are; 1.) the air temperature, and 2.) the relative humidity. The heat index reflects the combination of these two elements. We will rely on the heat index reading that is updated hourly by the National Weather Service.

The Parks and Recreation Department has defined five heat index zones based on recommended guidelines published by the American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM) for participation in outdoor activities during periods of extreme heat. Because the heat index does not take into account wind and direct sunlight, two degrees will be added to the stated heat index on sunny and still days. Likewise, two degrees will be subtracted on cloudy and windy days.

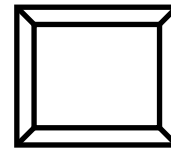
<b>WHITE</b> Heat index between 65-81°	Participants are in very little danger from heat and no special measures will be taken above regularly scheduled water breaks.
<b>GREEN</b> Heat index between 82-98°	Participants are in very little danger from heat and no special measure will be taken above the regularly scheduled water breaks and shaded activities as deemed necessary. Staff/Volunteers to monitor participants individually.
<b>YELLOW</b> Heat index between 98-105°	Each participant MUST have water to be allowed to participate in any outdoor activity. Ample amounts of water will be provided and participants will be allowed to take in as much water as desired. Staff/Volunteer-monitored water break required for all participants. Staff/Volunteer will instruct all players to stay hydrated and take frequent breaks on their own as well. Staff/Volunteers to monitor participants individually.
<b>RED</b> Heat index between 106-114°	All previous measures will be followed plus outdoor activities will be reduced by 15 minutes. Staff/Volunteer-monitored water breaks are required every 30 minutes for 5-10 minute durations. Staff/Volunteers to monitor participants individually.
<b>BLACK</b> Heat index above 115°	Kingsville Parks & Recreation Department will postpone or cancel all outdoor activities in direct sunlight until the heat index is below 114°.

During the course of the day, the heat index will rise and fall depending upon the time of day, amount of wind, cloud cover, etc. The above program modifications may also change throughout the course of the day. All other outdoor activities will be modified by staff on site.

The above recommendations are merely guidelines and it is the responsibility of parents to make the ultimate decision as to the participation of their child in City of Kingsville Parks and Recreation programs when heat may be a factor, taking into consideration the age and physical condition of their child. Parents also have the ultimate responsibility to inform their child about the dangers of heat and the need for protection, including sunscreen and proper hydration. Parents/guardians are expected to know their child better than the staff/volunteer. Parents/guardians are responsible for communicating with the staff/volunteer about their child's susceptibility to heat related illness, and to take other precautions that the parents/guardians believe are appropriate if they believe that weather or heat conditions place their child at risk of heat related illness or other danger, including withholding their child from participation.
