IV. <u>Petitions, Grievances, and Presentations.²</u>

1. Interim City Manager's Report. (Interim City Manager).

Mr. John Garcia stated city crews are doing preparation work on the Ailsie Street project and should be completed prior to the end of the end, and then the contractor will take over.

2. City Attorney's Report. (City Attorney).

Ms Courtney Alvarez informed the commission of H.B. 1204, which passed during the 78th Legislative Session, modifies several provisions of Chapter 242. The bill states cities and counties need to reach a mutual agreement so that one or the other regulates plats that are in within the ETJ by January 1, 2006 and if no agreement is reached they must go into arbitration.

3. Mayor and City Commissioner's Reports. (City Commission).

Commissioner Garcia stated his concern for minutes not being available for review.

Mayor Esquivel stated the CBCOG approved resolutions for grant funding for a community master plan and support for the Irma Rangel School of Pharmacy. He also stated he was invited by Governor Rick Perry to attend a luncheon this week with President Vicente Fox of Mexico.

1. <u>Executive Session: Under Section 551.071 of the Texas Open</u> <u>Meetings Act, the City Commission shall convene in Executive Session to</u> <u>seek legal advice from the City Attorney regarding pending litigation</u> <u>concerning Carla Lee Suson vs. Irene Ramirez, City Secretary of the City</u> <u>of Kingsville, et. al. No. 13-03-00470-CV, in the Court of Appeals</u> Thirteenth Judicial District of Texas. (City Attorney).

Pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Texas Open Meetings Act, the City Commission convened into executive session at 6:05 p.m. to seek legal advice from Mr. Augustin Rivera, Jr. regarding pending litigation of Case No. 13-03-00470-CV, Suson vs. Ramirez.

The Commission reconvened into open session at 6:38 p.m.

2. <u>Discuss and consider authorizing attorney Augustin Rivera, Jr. to</u> take further legal action on behalf of the City of Kingsville. (Mayor <u>Esquivel</u>).

A motion was made by Commissioner Castillo and seconded by Commissioner Pecos to authorize legal advisor Augustin Rivera, Jr. to pursue the legal defense of the city's policy regarding the interpretation of the city charter on recall elections. Motion passed, 3/2, with Commissioners Wilson and Garcia voting against the motion.

3. <u>Review 1973 Master plan Study to give staff direction to begin to</u> revisit, change accordingly, and bring up-to-date. (Mayor Esquivel). After a brief discussion by Mayor Esquivel, a motion was made by Commissioner Castillo and seconded by Commissioner Wilson to direct the interim city manager and staff to revisit, change accordingly and bring up to date the 1973 master plan study by Carter and Burgess. Motion carried, 5/0.
