1. MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSIONERS REPORTS. (CITY COMMISSION).

V. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION BY COMMISSIONERS.⁴

1. <u>Consider resolution for the suspension and removal of</u> Hector Hinojosa as City Manager and stating reasons for his removal. (Commissioner Pecos).

Commissioner Pecos stated that he had eight reasons for Mr. Hinojosa's removal. He stated: (1) inadequate communication with City Commissioners on going projects, jobs, issues and concerns; (2) lacks skills in communicating with the citizens in not responding to their problems, concerns or issues; (3) fails to complete or implement ideas suggested on numerous occasions by the city commission; (4) fails to anticipate problems, and does not develop effective plans on how to solve them; (5) reactive to situations instead of being proactive; (6) seldom represents the City in community activities; (7) fails to treat City employees with proper respect; and (8) loss of grant opportunities or monies for not submitting proper documentation.

Commissioner Castillo made motion to adopt this resolution, seconded by Commissioner Pecos.

Commissioner Garcia requested a point of order, directed to the City Attorney. He stated that on situations where the commission is going to move on an item of personnel hiring or firing, is an executive session needed, as a courtesy.

Ms Courtney Alvarez stated that this has been a practice and it is not a requirement. She added it was suggested, but was declined by the person requesting the item be put on the agenda.

The motion carried, 3/2, with Commissioners Wilson and Garcia casting the dissenting votes.

2. <u>Consider appointment of an Interim City Manager.</u> (Commissioner Pecos).

Commissioner Pecos made a motion to appoint Corando Garza, Assistant City Manager as Interim City Manager, seconded by Commissioner Castillo. Mayor Esquivel stated that it is custom that the Assistant City Manager is the next in charge.

The motion carried, 3/2, with Commissioners Wilson and Garcia casting the dissenting votes.
