

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2010

The City of Kingsville purchases natural gas from Centerpoint Energy. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 5,305 thousand cubic feet of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from Direct Energy. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 8,257,317 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases some of its water from the South Texas Water Authority. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 170,952,557 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in calendar year 2010 is \$1,387,961.35.
