SUBJECT: Receipt of \$25,000 donation from Vishal Raju Bhagat Foundation

### **Summary:**

The Parks & Recreation Department would like approval from City Commission to receive a \$25,000 donation from the Vishal Raju Bhagat Foundation. These funds would be used to help with the cost of constructing a dog park in Dick Kleberg Park. The park would be constructed near the site recommended by the Parks Master Plan.

### Background:

The Foundation focuses its efforts on building sustainable relationships within local communities to provide a positive, direct effect on the beneficiaries of its grants. The primary fund-raising event is the Annual Vishal Bhagat Memorial Golf Tournament, and through support from sponsors, partners, and volunteers have raised over \$1,100,000 for charity.

#### **Financial Impact:**

The donation of \$25,000 will help with the construction costs for a formal dog park to be built in Dick Kleberg Park.

#### Recommendation:

We recommend that City Commission authorize the receipt of this donation in the amount of \$25,000 from the Vishal Raju Bhagat Foundation, and amend the budget to record the acceptance of these funds into the parks budget.

SUBJECT: Budget Amendment-Municipal Building Renovations

#### Summary:

This item authorizes the approval of a budget amendment to reallocate funds to the Municipal Building renovation budget in UF Capital Projects Fund 054-5-6201-71300 Building.

#### Background:

Construction costs and furniture estimates show additional funds will be needed to complete the Municipal Building renovation project. The following transfers and adjustments are proposed in the attached budget amendment.

- Utility Fund to Utility Fund Capital Projects
  - o Reduce \$95,580 from 051-5-7003-71200 Machinery/Equipment.
- CO Series 2011-Utility Fund Water Production to CO Series 2011-Utility Fund Sewer Construction
  - \$95,580 from 066-5-6002-72025 Water Well #25 to 066-5-7003-71200
     Machinery/Equipment for Sewer Construction Equipment purchases.
- Insurance Claim Recovery Fund to Utility Fund Capital Projects
  - \$120,000 from 096-2-61002 Restricted-Insurance Claim Recovery to transfer to Fund 054-UF Capital projects for 054-5-6201-71300 Building.

#### **Financial Impact:**

A total of \$215,580 will be will be added to the Municipal Building Renovation Project line item 054-5-6201-71300 Building. \$95,580 of Waste Water Sewer Construction equipment purchases will be funded from CO 2011 instead of the Utility Fund. The Utility Fund will then transfer \$95,580 to the Municipal Building Renovation Project in Fund 054-UF Capital Projects. Unspent funds of \$120,000 in the Insurance Claim Recovery Fund will be transferred to Fund 054-UF Capital Projects.

#### Recommendation:

Staff recommends authorization of this budget amendment to complete this capital project.

The Municipal Building First Floor Renovations Architect Solka Nava Torno Inc. reviewed qualifications and discussed the two firm's bids based on a point evaluation system. The Municipal Building First Floor Renovations Architect Solka Nava Torno recommends Rusty Van Fleet to be the best firm for the City of Kingsville Municipal Building First Floor Renovations. **Summary:** In April of 2016 the City Commission approved the waiver of building permit fees for three homes to be built in the HOME program. At this point two have been built at 1745 E. Avenue F and 1111 E. Kleberg. Now the time is right for the third home to be built.

Background: The HOME program has allowed homeowners who live in near sub-standard homes to have them remodeled or replaced with new homes. The applicant has to be approved by the state and everything has to be in order with their application. This is the third and final applicant that will be getting a home built in Kingsville in this grant cycle. We have waived the building fees in the past which goes toward the cash match that is required as a part of the program.

**Financial Impact:** The building permit fee is \$264.96. The existing water and sewer taps will be used so there is no fee there according to the contractor.

**Recommendation:** Waive the building permit fee of \$264.96 for the home to be built at 902 E. Lott under the HOME Program.
