Kleberg County & City of Kingsville Confirm Seventeen COVID-19 Cases, Twenty Probable Cases, Two COVID-19 Related Deaths

KINGSVILLE, TX – Kleberg County Judge Rudy Madrid and the City of Kingsville Mayor Sam Fugate received confirmation from the Texas Department of State Health Services, Region 11 of 17 additional COVID-19 cases and 20 probable cases. Fourteen of the newly reported COVID-19 cases are considered active and 19 of the probable cases are considered active, all active cases are being monitored by Region 11. DSHS has also reported an additional two COVID-19 related deaths. These numbers represent **eight days** of data.

The newly confirmed novel coronavirus cases bring our cumulative count in Kleberg County to 1,886. Our probable cumulative count is 651. To date, there have been 90 COVID-19-related deaths in Kleberg County. Texas DSHS is reporting 41 individuals removed from isolation today. Our confirmed active COVID-19 case count decreases to 79. Region 11 is no longer reporting transmission type, but they are reporting pervasive community spread of COVID-19 in our region. All individuals confirmed with active cases are in isolation and will continue to be monitored by Region 11.

Both city and county leaders are stressing the importance of following all CDC guidelines and recommendations. Please remember to socially distance, wear masks when distancing is not possible and frequently wash your hands. Stay home if you feel sick and isolate if you test positive for COVID-19. Kleberg County is currently working with the state to assure all individuals in our region who would like the vaccine are vaccinated for protection from COVID-19. **To register for vaccination, please visit www.klebergvaccineclinic.com**, if you are unable to do so, call (361) 595-8577. Appointments are also being scheduled at the Kleberg County Vaccination Clinic, located at 1724 Brahma Blvd, Suite 106. The county is currently administering Moderna, available to anyone 18 years old and up. Christus Spohn is hosting a first and second dose Pfizer clinic Monday, April 12th from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Since March 2020 there have been **1,886 confirmed cases** of novel coronavirus in Kleberg County and **651 probable cases**. **Today's reported cases represent eight days of March and April data.** Previously reported cases are as follows:
