Brookshire Pool can be rented out for special occasions for only a small fee.

To reserve the pool there is a **deposit of \$100.00** that must be paid at the Dick Kingsville Park office in order to reserve your date and time. The pool rents for **\$50.00 per hour** with a 4 hour max. This will be determined by a headcount of how many people are anticipated attend the party. And **\$15.00 per hour for each guard required**. Reservations are to be made at the Kingsville Parks Office. The rental time includes clean-up time. Any changes or cancellations must be made at least two weeks in advance to qualify for deposit refund. You will be provided pool rules and you must make sure that your party attendees follow all rules as well.
