

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2021

The City of Kingsville purchases natural gas from CenterPoint Energy. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of 1,263 hundred cubic feet (CCF) of natural gas.

The City purchased electricity from GEXA Energy and Nueces Electric Cooperative. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of 10,405,914 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from STWA and Ricardo Water Supply. In calendar year 2021, the City purchased a total of 134,387,530 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in calendar year 2021 is \$1,335,322.48
