General Land Office (GLO) and Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) Construction Locations and Timelines



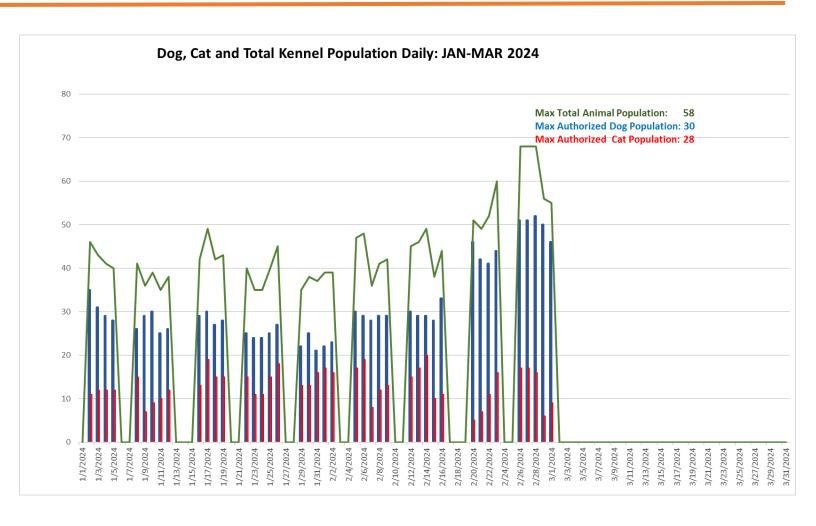
