This notice informs taxpayers of the potential impact of the proposed budget and tax rate for Fiscal Year 2025-26, comparing what would be paid under the no-new-revenue tax rate versus the proposed tax rate.

Calculations:

-Prior Year Tax Bill: $(\$116,465/100) \times 0.77000 = \$1,164$

-No-New-Revenue Tax Bill: (\$130,620/100) x 0.71665= \$936

-Proposed Tax Bill: $(\$130,620/100) \times 0.76918 = \$1,004$

Summary:

If the City of Kingsville adopts the proposed tax rate of \$0.76918 per \$100 valuation, the average homestead owner would pay approximately \$68 more annually compared to the nonew-revenue tax rate.
